Introduction to Child-centered Play Therapy

(2 Days – Face to Face Training)
(12 Contact Training Hours)

Course Description:

Child-centered play therapy (CCPT) is acknowledged to be one of the historically significant theories in the field of play therapy by the Association for Play Therapy, USA (APT). This is a non-directive approach to promote the children's positive growth experience in the presence of an understanding, accepting and supportive therapist. This 2-day introductory course is designed for beginners to explore the therapeutic power of play.

Content and Learning Objectives:

After attending this two-day training, participants will be able to:

Day 1:

1. Acquire basic knowledge of the history and development of CCPT
2. Explain the meanings and functions of play
3. Outline the key concepts of CCPT
4. Describe the importance of building a therapeutic relationship
5. Articulate essential play therapy skills of CCPT
6. Outline the stages in CCPT process

Day 2:

7. Identify the differences of CCPT from other play therapy approaches
8. Describe the qualities of being a CCPT therapist
9. Identify the rationales behind playroom setup and for selecting toys
10. Describe the reference points for determining termination
11. Explain the concept of play therapy to parents
12. Overview contemporary research on CCPT
