Let's Practice ~ Child-centered Play Therapy

(3 Days – Face to Face Training)
(18 Contact Training Hours)

Course Description:

This training is the practicum course of the Introduction of Child-Centered Play Therapy. With reviewing participant's videotaped play sessions, participants will deepen and consolidate their skills and confidence in applying child-centered play therapy in their clinical settings.

Target Participants: Social workers, counsellors and other mental health professionals who had full attendance of “Introduction of Child-Centered Play Therapy” and interested in deepening the related experience.

Medium of Instruction: Cantonese (supplement with English and Chinese handouts)

Mode of Delivery: Face to Face Training

Learning Activities: Video review, Article discussions, experiential activities and lectures
Each participant has to present 3 videotaped sessions (around 30-45mins each) applying the child-centered play therapy concepts and skills under the consent of the child and parents.
